



Uniform Policy

Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- Promotes a sense of pride in the school
- Engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school. Pupils make a commitment that when they put on their St. Michael's Uniform, they will abide by the rules of the school community
- Identifies the children with the school
- Protects children from social pressures to dress in a particular way and makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- Is regarded as suitable wear for school
- Is designed with health and safety in mind

Racial Equality & Equal Opportunities

All children have equal access to wearing school uniform regardless of their culture, race, religion, gender, disability or ability. We ensure that the set uniform respects other policies such as equality, race relations, and sex discrimination and allows for individual sets of circumstances of all groups and individuals. St. Michael's School is committed to creating a positive climate that will enable everyone to work free from racial intimidation and harassment to achieve their full potential.

Jewellery

Children are only allowed to wear small studded earrings which must be removed during P.E lessons or covered with tape. Children can wear a watch for school but this must not be a smart watch/device.

Hair

Extreme hair colouring and styles are not acceptable (for example, Mohican cuts, long spiked hair, undercuts and tramlines). Long hair must be tied back.
