SUZY EDDIE IZZARD BRINGS SHAKESPEARE TO LOUTH KS2 PUPILS

Suzy Eddie Izzard Brings Shakespeare to Louth KS2 Pupils

World-renowned performer to visit St Michael's CofE Primary School on 3rd November.

Internationally acclaimed actor, comedian and campaigner **Suzy Eddie Izzard** will visit **St Michael's CofE Primary School** in Louth on **Monday 3rd November** at the invitation of the **Creativity Academy**, a Lincolnshire-based charity dedicated to inspiring creativity and confidence in young people.

Currently touring the world with her celebrated solo production *The Tragedy of Hamlet*, Izzard will meet pupils and staff before performing selected scenes from her show — fresh from sell-out runs in London and on Broadway.

The visit will include a discussion between Izzard and Ben Keaton, multi award-winning actor, writer and director, and founder of the Creativity Academy. The two first worked together on the London comedy circuit.

“Our aim has always been to give children direct access to outstanding creative minds — to show them that art, performance and ideas belong to everyone,” said Ben Keaton, founder of the Creativity Academy. “Eddie’s visit will be an unforgettable experience for these young people and a brilliant reminder of what’s possible when imagination meets courage.”
